Rights Respecting Schools

A few years ago, our school was accredited with the Silver: Rights Aware award for being a Rights Respecting School. Silver: Rights Aware is the second stage of the Rights Respecting Schools Award. It is granted by UNICEF UK to schools that show good progress towards embedding children's rights in the school's policy, practice and ethos, as outlined in the RRSA Strands and Outcomes. We are hoping to reaccredit our Silver award this year. Each week at Assembly, we have been focusing on the UNCRC Article of the Week and have been sharing what that means with our pupils. Next term, the Rights Respecting Group will be involved in promoting Rights within our school through Assemblies and using Social Media.
